

ORDINANCE NO. 2002-97

**AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS BY THE MASON MUNICIPAL COURT FOR THE PURCHASE OF DOLBY DIGITAL RECORDING SERVICES FOR THE MASON MUNICIPAL COURT, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PURCHASE ORDER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Judge George M. Parker, Mason Municipal Court, has issued an order that Dolby digital recording services and equipment should be purchased from Dolby Digital Recording without advertisement or competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, the Judge has indicated that there exists a real and present emergency in connection with the purchase of said services and equipment; and

WHEREAS, said funds are to be expended from the Court Clerk's Computer Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring (not less than five (5) members):

Section 1. That the Mason Municipal Court is hereby authorized to expend funds for the purchase of Dolby digital recording services for the Mason Municipal Court.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a purchase order in the amount of \$15,969.00 payable to Dolby Digital Recording for Dolby digital recording services for the Mason Municipal Court, according to the specifications set forth by the City.


Section 3. That the City Council determines that there is a real and present emergency.


Section 4. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said Dolby Digital Recording in an amount not to exceed \$15,969.00 for said Dolby digital recording services.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said emergency is the need to purchase the equipment at the earliest possible date.
