

ORDINANCE NO. 2003-07

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH HORTON EMERGENCY VEHICLES FOR THE PURCHASE OF A 2003 HORTON SQUAD FOR USE BY THE CITY OF MASON FIRE DEPARTMENT, DETERMINING A PUBLIC EXIGENCY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has advertised and received bids for the purchase of ambulances;

WHEREAS, Horton Emergency Vehicles was the best bidder with a bid of \$169,234.05 for the purchase of a 2003 Horton Squad.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the State's ambulance specifications and agrees that Horton Emergency Vehicles is the best bidder.


Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Horton Emergency Vehicles for the purchase of a 2003 Horton Squad.


Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Horton Emergency Vehicles the sum of \$169,234.05 for ambulance.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediately preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to perform the work at the earliest possible date.
