

ORDINANCE NO. 2003-08

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH HORTON EMERGENCY VEHICLES FOR THE REHABILITATION OF A 1996 HORTON SQUAD, DETERMINING A PUBLIC EXIGENCY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, it is necessary to rehabilitate a 1996 Horton Squad used by the City of Mason Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, Horton Emergency Vehicles has submitted a proposal to perform said rehabilitation for the sum of \$20,590.54; and

WHEREAS, a public exigency exists requiring the work to be performed by Horton Emergency Vehicles, as the squad was built by Horton Emergency Vehicles and is currently under warranty, and the warranty will be voided if another vendor were to attempt the work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Horton Emergency Vehicles for the rehabilitation of a 1996 Horton Squad.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Horton Emergency Vehicles the sum of \$20,590.54 for said rehab work.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediately preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to perform the work at the earliest possible date.
