

ORDINANCE NO. 2003-108

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SANDERSON CMI FOR COMPUTER EQUIPMENT AND SERVICES IN THE MASON MUNICIPAL COURT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Sanderson CMI for a web connection application, hardware, services and fees in the Mason Municipal Court, in accordance with the proposal submitted by Sanderson CMI, which proposal is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and incorporated herein by reference.


Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said Sanderson CMI an amount not to exceed \$43,752.00 for said computer equipment and services.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to complete this project at the earliest possible date
