

ORDINANCE NO. 2003-135

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PROVIDE UP TO \$6,600.00 TO CINCINNATI METRO TO CONTINUE THE 71/72 REVERSE COMMUTE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SERVICE FROM THE CITY OF CINCINNATI TO THE CITY OF MASON

WHEREAS, the City of Mason desires that public transportation service continue to and from the City of Cincinnati, and that can be accomplished through a collaborative effort among Hamilton County, the City of Mason, and Deerfield Township; and

WHEREAS, said funding will provide continued bus service to employees of City of Mason businesses who rely on public transportation to get to their jobs; and

WHEREAS, contingent upon the financial contribution of Hamilton County and Deerfield Township, the City of Mason wishes to contribute up to \$6,600.00 so that the Reverse Commute public transportation system will continue to be available from the City of Cincinnati to the City of Mason for fiscal year 2004.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Cincinnati Metro to provide funding of continued public transportation service to the City of Mason.


Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay up to \$6,600.00 to Cincinnati Metro to continue said service.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
