

ORDINANCE NO. 2003-149

**AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2001-219 TO ESTABLISH NEW RATES  
FOR THE MASON COMMUNITY CENTER**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 2001-219 is hereby amended to establish the following rates for daily admissions and annual passes for use of the Mason Community Center:

DAILY RATES:	RESIDENTS	NONRESIDENTS	CORPORATE
Adults (17+ years)	\$7.00	\$10.00	\$8.00
Youth (under 17 years)	\$5.00	\$8.00	
Senior	\$5.00	\$8.00	\$6.00

Daily admissions purchased may be credited toward the purchase of an annual pass purchased on the same day. A daily admission receipt is required.

ANNUAL PASSES:	RESIDENTS	NONRESIDENTS	CORPORATE
Adults (17+ years)	\$285.00	\$440.00	\$360.00
Youth (under 17 years)	\$160.00	\$255.00	\$200.00
Senior	\$160.00	\$255.00	\$200.00
Family (household)	\$450.00	\$675.00	\$565.00

THREE MONTH PASSES:	RESIDENTS	NONRESIDENTS	CORPORATE
Adults (17+ years)	\$91.00	\$130.00	\$110.00
Youth (under 17 years)	\$60.00	\$84.00	\$70.00
Senior	\$60.00	\$84.00	\$70.00

Resident is defined as any citizen who lives in the City of Mason and/or the Mason City School District.

Senior is defined as any adult 60 years of age and older and/or a Bridge member 55-59 year of age.

Family is defined as a married couple or single adult, and any children residing in the same household and claimed on their most recent federal income tax return.

Corporate Rate is applicable to any individual employed fulltime (at least 35 hours per week) in the City of Mason corporate limits, and that individual's family.


Section 2. That the above fees shall be applicable toward any passes or renewals purchased on or after January 1, 2004.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
