

ORDINANCE NO. 2003-152

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CUSTOM DESIGN BENEFITS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADMINISTERING THE EMPLOYEE MEDICAL INSURANCE PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the City of Mason sought the most efficient administration of its employee medical insurance coverage; and

WHEREAS, prospective vendors were encouraged to submit proposals which included provisions for the retention of the maximum reasonable medical financial risk; and

WHEREAS, after careful review, the proposal for a partially self-funded plan submitted by Custom Design Benefits is deemed to be the best proposal.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members thereto concurring:


Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Custom Design Benefits for the purpose of administering the City's partially self-funded employee medical insurance coverage program according to the terms set out in the attached Exhibit "A", which is incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
