

ORDINANCE NO. 2003-16

**APPROVING THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
THE CITY OF MASON AND TRUCK DRIVERS, CHAUFFEURS AND  
HELPERS LOCAL 100, AND AUTHORIZING  
THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT, AND DECLARING  
AN EMERGENCY**

BE IT ORDAINED the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the collective bargaining agreement between the City of Mason and the Truck Drivers, Chauffeurs and Helpers Local 100, setting forth certain terms and conditions of employment of the bargaining unit members, is hereby approved, and a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute such agreement on behalf of the City of Mason.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to implement the terms agreed upon and to pay bargaining unit members pursuant to the agreement concluded in September, 2003.
