

ORDINANCE NO. 2003-20

CREATING THE POSITION OF MECHANIC/MAINTENANCE WORKER IN THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT AND FIXING THAT POSITION AS A FLOATING COMPLEMENT POSITION AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THAT COMPENSATION FOR SUCH POSITION BE FIXED PURSUANT TO THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MASON AND TRUCK DRIVERS, CHAUFFEURS AND HELPERS LOCAL 100.

BE IT ORDAINED the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That there is hereby created the position of Mechanic/Maintenance Worker in the Public Works Department in the City of Mason.

Section 2. The position of Mechanic/Maintenance Worker shall be a full time equivalent position in the complement of the Public Works Department, which shall be subject to change to Mechanic or to Maintenance Worker in the event that the City Manager deems that there is no longer a need for the position of Mechanic/Maintenance Worker.


Section 3. That said Mechanic/Maintenance Worker's compensation for such position shall be fixed pursuant to the collective bargaining agreement between the City of Mason and Truck Drivers, Chauffeurs and Helpers Local 100.

Section 4. That the City Manager shall be authorized to change this full time equivalent complement position to the complement of Maintenance Worker or to the complement of Mechanics, at his discretion, provided that such change shall not result in an increase in the total complement of the Public Works Department.

Section 5. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
