

ORDINANCE NO. 2003-38

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR AN OHIO SMALL CITIES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FOR REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT OF HANDICAP ACCESSIBLE CURB RAMPS ALONG U.S. 42 AND VARIOUS OTHER LOCATIONS THROUGHOUT THE CITY.

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City of Mason to seek funds to assist in economic and community development; and

WHEREAS, it was agreed that the City should submit an application for funds for the replacement of handicap accessible ramps along U.S. 42 and various other locations throughout the city.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to submit an application for an Ohio Small Cities Community Development Block Grant for the replacement of handicap accessible curb ramps along U.S. 42 and various other locations throughout the city.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
