

ORDINANCE NO. 2003-82

AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MASON TO SPONSOR A TABLE AT THE  
AUGUST 9, 2003 DINNER AND CONCERT CELEBRATING THE  
BICENTENNIAL OF WARREN COUNTY, OHIO

WHEREAS, 2003 is the bicentennial year of both the State of Ohio and Warren County, which was one of Ohio's first 12 counties and is Ohio's second fastest growing county; and

WHEREAS, along with most, if not all, of the other communities in Warren County, the City of Mason has participated in various civic events commemorating Warren County's Bicentennial year; and

WHEREAS, the Warren County Commissioners and the Warren County Convention & Visitor's Bureau are hosting a celebration including a dinner and patriotic concert featuring singer/songwriter Lee Greenwood at the Warren County Fairgrounds on Saturday, August 9, 2003;

WHEREAS, the Council finds it salutary to celebrate Warren County's heritage, to promote good intergovernmental relations between the City of Mason, Warren County, and the other communities within Warren County, and therefore, finds it beneficial to the City of Mason to sponsor a table at the dinner and concert;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager, on behalf of the City of Mason, is authorized to sponsor a table at the Warren County Bicentennial dinner and concert at the Warren County Fairgrounds on August 9, 2003;

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay the sum of \$400.00 to the Warren County Convention & Visitors Bureau for this table sponsorship.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
