

ORDINANCE NO. 2003-86

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING FUNDS THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT GRANT

WHEREAS, the City of Mason proposes to enter into an Agreement with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) toward the modification of culvert materials, modification of the existing Pine Hill Lake Dam and sedimentation removal along the lake's edge at Pine Hill Lake Park; and

WHEREAS, by entering into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for the grant, the City of Mason will realize cost benefits and be able to complete work associated with the Pine Hill Lake Improvement Project.

WHEREAS, the City has submitted all requested information for the Ohio Department of Natural Resources to review and process in the acquisition of said grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute any and all documents necessary to acquire said grant.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
