

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-104

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE BARRETT PAVING FOR TYLERSVILLE CROSSING IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, bids were received for the Tylersville Crossing improvement project; and
WHEREAS, Barrett Paving was the lowest and best bidder with a bid of \$928,832.61 for said Tylersville Crossing improvement project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the bid of the Barrett Paving in the amount of \$928,832.61 is hereby accepted as the lowest and best bid for the Tylersville Crossing improvement project.


Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Barrett Paving for the Tylersville Crossing improvement project, according to the specifications set forth by the City.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said Barrett Paving an amount not to exceed \$928,832.61 for the Tylersville Crossing improvement project.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to execute the contract prior to the expiration date of the bid and to implement the completion of said public improvement.
