

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-125

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2003-149 TO ESTABLISH NEW RATES FOR THE MASON COMMUNITY CENTER

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 2003-149 is hereby amended to establish the following rates for daily admissions and annual passes for use of the Mason Community Center:

DAILY RATES:	RESIDENTS	NONRESIDENTS	CORPORATE
Adults (17+ years)	\$7.00	\$10.00	\$8.00
Youth (4-16 years)	\$5.00	\$ 8.00	
Senior (60+ years)	\$5.00	\$ 8.00	\$5.00

Daily admissions purchased may be credited toward the purchase of an annual pass purchased on the same day. A daily admission receipt is required.

SUBSCRIPTION PASSES:	RESIDENTS	NONRESIDENTS	CORPORATE

Resident is defined as any citizen who lives in the City of Mason and/or the Mason City School District.

Senior is defined as any adult 60 years of age and older and/or a Bridge member 55-59 years of age.

Family is defined as a married couple or single adult, and any children residing in the same household and claimed on their most recent federal income tax return.

Corporate Rate is defined as applicable to any individual employed fulltime (at least 35 hours per week) in the City of Mason corporate limits, and that individual's family.

Subscription Rate is defined as a self-renewing family admission based on an initial sign-up fee and monthly electronic withdrawal of subscription fees from a qualified checking, savings, or credit account to continue through any future rate increases and until canceled by the pass owner or City.

Three-Month Pass is defined as admission for 90 consecutive days.

Section 2. That the above daily, annual and three-month fees shall be applicable toward any passes purchased on or after January 1, 2005, and on renewals of passes expiring in 2005.

Section 3. That the Subscription Pass rates shall be effective after November 1, 2004.


Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
