

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-142

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH EVERYBODY'S FARM, INC., TO CONSTRUCT A NEW BRIDGE AND 400 FEET OF SNIDER ROAD OVER THE MUDDY CREEK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Everybody's Farm, Inc., and the City of Mason, desire to build a new bridge and 400 feet of Snider Road over the Muddy Creek; and

WHEREAS, by entering into a cooperative agreement with Everybody's Farm, Inc. for the construction of said improvements, the City of Mason will realize cost benefits, minimize permit requirements and minimize impacts to the State of Ohio Property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Everybody's Farm, Inc. to construct a new bridge and 400 feet of Snider Road over the Muddy Creek.


Section 2. That said agreement provides for the payment of all costs related to the design, construction and maintenance of said improvement be paid by City of Mason.


Section 3. That the terms of the agreement are as set out in the attached Exhibit "A" which is incorporated herein by reference.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to preclude flooding in the area of Davis Run at the earliest possible date.
