

**MODIFYING THE COMPENSATION FOR PROSECUTION SERVICES
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That Robert W. Peeler, as the Prosecutor for the Mason Municipal Court, shall be paid \$46,000.00 per year, plus any amount paid to him by Warren County. Additionally, said Prosecutor shall receive the same health care and other benefits provided for all full-time City employees.

Section 2. That said Prosecutor shall receive the amount of \$30,000.00 as a contribution toward the cost of providing the necessary Assistant Prosecutor(s) to meet the prosecutorial needs of the Mason Municipal Court.


Section 3. That said Prosecutor shall receive the amount of \$30,000.00 as a contribution toward the administrative costs incurred in running the Prosecutor's office, i.e., secretarial, paralegal and miscellaneous positions.

Section 4. That said Prosecutor shall receive the amount of \$25,000.00 per year as a contribution toward the cost of providing clerical assistance for the maintenance of prosecutorial files.

Section 5. That said Prosecutor, or his designated Assistant, shall perform the following duties: prosecute all matters in Mason Municipal Court, including tax matters and Building Code matters, as well as all other criminal and traffic matters, advise and counsel members of the City of Mason Police Department regarding these prosecutions, and handle all other matters that may arise related to prosecutions.


Section 6. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
