

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-20

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH VOGELPOHL FIRE EQUIPMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF FIREFIGHTER TURN-OUT GEAR FOR USE BY THE CITY OF MASON FIRE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has advertised and received bids for the purchase of firefighter turn-out gear;

WHEREAS, Vogelpohl Fire Equipment was the best bidder with a bid of \$87,990.00 for the purchase of 70 sets of firefighter turn-out gear.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the State's firefighter turn-out gear specifications and agrees that Vogelpohl Fire Equipment is the best bidder.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Vogelpohl Fire Equipment for the purchase of 70 sets of firefighter turn-out gear.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Vogelpohl Fire Equipment the sum of \$87,990.00 for said firefighter turn-out gear.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to secure the current pricing and delivery of equipment.
