

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-37

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE NELSON STARK CO. FOR PLUMBING CONSTRUCTION (CONTRACT D) NECESSARY FOR THE NEW WATER RECLAMATION PLANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to public bidding, bids have been received for Plumbing Construction (Contract D) necessary for the new Water Reclamation Plant; and

WHEREAS, The Nelson Stark Co. is the lowest and best bidder with a bid of \$372,500.00 for said Plumbing Construction (Contract D).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, five members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the bid of The Nelson Stark Co. in the amount of \$372,500.00 is hereby accepted as the lowest and best bid for Plumbing Construction (Contract D) necessary for the new Water Reclamation Plant.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with The Nelson Stark Co. for the Plumbing Construction (Contract D) necessary for the new Water Reclamation Plant, according to the specifications set forth by the City.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said The Nelson Stark Co. an amount not to exceed \$372,500.00 for said Plumbing Construction (Contract D).

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to secure the current bid and pricing of the contract.
