

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-66

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MACTEC TO PROVIDE MATERIAL TESTING SERVICES FOR THE NEW WATER RECLAMATION PLANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mason is constructing a new Water Reclamation Plant at 3200 Mason-Morrow-Millgrove Road; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to secure professional services for the testing of the materials utilized and placed during construction of said Water Reclamation Plant; and

WHEREAS, the City has obtained proposals from a number of competent firms practicing in this area; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that the most qualified and competitive firm to provide said testing services is MACTEC Engineering and Testing, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the estimated not-to-exceed cost of the services to be provided is \$240,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the proposal received from MACTEC Engineering and Testing, Inc. for provision of material testing services is the most qualified and competitive.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with MACTEC Engineering and Testing, Inc. for material testing services for the new Water Reclamation Plant in an amount not to exceed \$240,000.00.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay MACTEC Engineering and Testing, Inc. an amount not to exceed \$240,000.00 for material testing services for the new Water Reclamation Plant under the contract.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to provide timely testing services for construction of the Water Reclamation Plant.
