

RESOLUTION NO. 2004-01

**REQUESTING THE DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION TO REVIEW THE ENGINEERING AND TRAFFIC INVESTIGATION AND DETERMINE AND DECLARE A SAFE AND REASONABLE SPEED LIMIT ON STATE ROUTE 741 BETWEEN US 42 NORTH TO APPROXIMATELY 1000 FEET NORTH OF BETHANY ROAD IN THE CITY OF MASON, OHIO**

WHEREAS, a request has been made to this Council that the statutory vehicular speed limit established by Sec. 4511.21, Revised Code of Ohio is greater than that considered reasonable and safe on State Route 741 between U.S. 42 north to approximately 1000 feet north of Bethany Road, and

WHEREAS, it is the belief of this Council that the statutory speed limit of 50 mph is unrealistic.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio:

Section 1. By virtue of the provisions of Sec. 4511.21, Revised Code of Ohio the Director of Transportation is hereby requested to determine and declare a reasonable and safe prima facie limit on State Route 741 between U.S. 42 north to approximately 1000 feet north of Bethany Road in Mason, Ohio.

Section 2. That when this Council is advised that the Director of Transportation has determined and declared a reasonable and safe speed limit on the section of road described in Section 1 hereof, standard signs, properly posted and giving notice thereof will be erected.

Section 3. That the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to forward a certified copy of this Resolution to the Ohio Department of Transportation.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
