

RESOLUTION NO. 2004-14

RESOLUTION ADOPTING A CDBG GENERAL ANTIDISPLACEMENT AND  
RELOCATION ASSISTANCE PLAN

WHEREAS, the Barney Frank Amendment to the Housing and Community Development Act has created substantial changes at the federal level affecting the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) funding programs administered by the Ohio Department of Development; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason, as a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) small cities grantee, is required to adopt a general antidisplacement and relocation assistance plan as a prerequisite to making application for the Comprehensive Housing/Neighborhood Revitalization Program.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, with 7 members thereto concurring:


Section 1. That the general antidisplacement and relocation assistance plan is hereby adopted to be administered by the City of Mason Economic Development Office in accordance with the procedures prescribed by the Ohio Department of Development, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. That the City Manager or his designated representative may sign the necessary certification related thereto.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
