

ORDINANCE NO. 2005-103

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE BOARD OF EDUCATION, MASON CITY SCHOOLS REGARDING THE PROVISION OF WATER AND SEWER TAPS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Board of education, Mason City Schools, regarding the provision of water and sewer taps.

Section 2. That said agreement shall be substantially in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the attached Exhibit "A" which is incorporated herein by reference.

Section 3. That the City Manager is authorized to take all additional steps to ensure compliance with the terms of said agreement.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary to provide for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the necessity to provide the required taps in order for the Board of Education to construct its improvements in a timely manner.
