

ORDINANCE NO. 2005-107

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH OHIO EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY TO PROVIDE INTERSTATE MUTUAL AID THROUGH THE "EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ASSISTANCE COMPACT" AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Ohio Emergency Management Agency to provide Interstate Mutual Aid through the "Emergency Management Assistance Compact" as a result of Hurricane Katrina.

Section 2. That in accordance with said Agreement, the City of Mason will provide its employees, specifically police, fire, EMS, service personnel and related resources, as requested during this assistance period.

Section 3. The City of Mason will seek reimbursement through the Ohio Emergency Management Agency.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to execute this Agreement at the soonest possible date.
