

ORDINANCE NO. 2005-26

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO MAKE PAYMENT TO THE GREATER CINCINNATI WATER WORKS OF TAP, METER AND VALVE FEES FOR WATER SERVICE TO THE CITY'S NEW WATER RECLAMATION PLANT

WHEREAS, The City of Mason is constructing a new Water Reclamation Plant (WRP) at 3600 Mason-Morrow-Millgrove Road, scheduled to be completed in early 2006, and

WHEREAS, said WRP will require provision of drinking water supply for its operation, and water for fire protection, and

WHEREAS, Greater Cincinnati Water Works (GCWW), a department of the City of Cincinnati, has agreed to supply drinking water and water for fire protection to the new WRP, and

WHEREAS, GCWW requires payment of \$26,796.36 for tap, meter and valve fees for provision of said drinking water and water for fire protection supply, in accordance with the provisions of the Retail Water Service Agreement between the City of Cincinnati and the City of Mason.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, six members thereto occurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager of the City of Mason is hereby authorized to agree to the payment to GCWW for tap, meter and valve fees in the total amount of \$26,796.36 for supply of drinking water and water for fire protection to the new WRP.

Section 2. That the Finance Director of the City of Mason is hereby authorized to pay said GCWW an amount not to exceed \$26,796.36 for supply of drinking water and water for fire protection to the new WRP.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
