

ORDINANCE NO. 2005-43

DECLARING CERTAIN CITY VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT, IMPOUNDED VEHICLES, AND CERTAIN MISCELLANEOUS CONFISCATED PROPERTY AND EQUIPMENT AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE, AUCTION AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR SALE OF SAID VEHICLES AND PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Council has determined that there are certain City vehicles and equipment, impounded vehicles and certain miscellaneous confiscated property and equipment which are not needed or are unfit for public use as set out in Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City vehicles and equipment, impounded vehicles, and certain miscellaneous confiscated property and equipment set out in the attached Exhibit "A", and included herein by reference, are declared to be surplus property no longer needed for municipal purposes or unfit for public use.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to sell said property and equipment in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15, which authorizes the City Manager to sell said property, the estimated value of which is less than \$1,000.00 without any formal bidding procedure or to sell said personal property or equipment that exceeds \$1,000.00 after advertisement for not less than two nor more than four weeks to the highest and best bidder.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
