

ORDINANCE NO. 2005-45

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CENTURY EQUIPMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) 2005 TORO GROUNDSMASTER MOWER

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has advertised and received bids for the purchase of vehicles, under the State Bid program; and

WHEREAS, Century Equipment was the best bidder with a bid of \$43,371.84 for the purchase of one (1) 2005 Toro Mower for use by the Parks Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the State's vehicle specifications and agrees that Century Equipment is the best bidder.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Century Equipment for the purchase of one (1) 2005 Toro Groundsmaster Mower.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Century Equipment the total sum of \$43,371.84 for said mower.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
