

ORDINANCE NO. 2005-48

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH KZF DESIGN TO COMPLETE THE DOWNTOWN STREETScape PLAN FOR EIGHT BLOCKS OF THE CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT FROM MASON ROAD TO KINGS MILLS ROAD ALONG MAIN STREET AND FROM MAIN STREET TO THIRD AVENUE ALONG U.S. 42/READING ROAD

WHEREAS, proposals have been solicited and received for planning services to provide a Downtown Streetscape Plan that includes infrastructure, landscaping and signage for eight blocks of the central business district from Mason Road to Kings Mills Road along Main Street and from Main Street to Third Avenue along U.S. 42/Reading Road; and

WHEREAS, KZF Design has submitted a proposal for an amount not to exceed \$127,500.00 for the professional services necessary to provide the Downtown Streetscape Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the proposal of KZF Design is an amount not to exceed \$127,500.00, and which is more fully detailed in the Proposed Scope of Services section of the Request for Proposal dated March 9, 2005, which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and is hereby accepted for the professional planning services necessary to provide a Downtown Streetscape Plan.

Section 2. That the City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with KZF Design according to the specifications set forth in Exhibit "A".

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said KZF Design an amount not to exceed \$127,500.00 for these professional planning services.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
