

ORDINANCE NO. 2005-51

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH GREATER CINCINNATI WATER WORKS REGARDING THE INSTALLATION OF STORM SEWER FOR KINGS MILLS ROAD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS; The Greater Cincinnati Water Works is installing watermain along Kings Mills Road between Cox-Smith Road and State Route 741, and

WHEREAS; The Greater Cincinnati Water Works contractor, Paul Rack Excavating and Paving Co., has submitted the attached proposal for the replacement of storm sewer in this area for an amount not to exceed \$36,232.00 for completion of the work specified in the Agreement, and

WHEREAS; Section 133.05 of the Codified Ordinances of Mason, Ohio requires that the Council approve any expenditure exceeding \$15,000.00; and

WHEREAS; the City of Mason Charter Section 5.04(J)(1) provides that an expenditure which exceeds the amount set by Council (\$15,000.00) for supplies, materials or labor may be made without advertisement and bidding when it is authorized by Ordinance of Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to reimburse Greater Cincinnati Water Works for their contractor, Paul Rack Excavating and Paving Co., as shown on the attached proposal hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 2. That the City Manager is authorized to execute other documents necessary to fulfil the terms of the Agreement.


Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said Greater Cincinnati Water Works an amount not to exceed \$36,232.00 for the Kings Mills Road Storm Sewer improvements.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to execute the contract prior to the expiration date of the bid and to implement the completion of said public improvement.
