

ORDINANCE NO. 2005-61

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SUTPHEN CORPORATION OF COLUMBUS, OHIO, FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE 2005 FIRE RESCUE-PUMPER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has advertised and received bids for the purchase of Fire Rescue-Pumpers; and

WHEREAS, Sutphen Corporation of Columbus, Ohio, is equal to or less than the best bidder with a price of \$445,673.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the State's fire rescue-pumper specifications and agrees that Sutphen Corporation of Columbus, Ohio, is equal to the best bidder.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Sutphen Corporation of Columbus, Ohio, for the purchase of one 2005 Fire Rescue-Pumper for use by the City of Mason Fire Department.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Sutphen Corporation of Columbus, Ohio, a sum not to exceed \$445,673 for said 2005 Fire Rescue-Pumper.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to execute the contract at the earliest possible date.
