

ORDINANCE NO. 2005-82

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH OCEAN SYSTEMS FOR THE PURCHASE OF AN AVID XPRESS VIDEO ENHANCEMENT/ANALYSIS SYSTEM FOR THE MASON POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Ocean Systems for the purchase of an Avid Xpress Video Enhancement/Analysis System, for the Mason Police Department, which is the only system compatible with the system used by Miami Valley Crime Laboratory, in accordance with the proposal, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Ocean Systems the sum of \$18,292.00 for the Avid Xpress Video Enhancement/Analysis System.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to execute the contract at the earliest possible date.
