

RESOLUTION NO. 2005-03

ARBOR DAY

**WHEREAS**, Arbor Day has been an occasion for recognizing the value of trees and woodlands to human welfare since 1872; and

**WHEREAS**, trees clean the air, moderate the temperature, reduce erosion of topsoil, cut heating and cooling costs, and provide habitat for wildlife; and

**WHEREAS**, trees are a renewable resource and beautify our residential and business areas; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mason has a tradition of supporting and encouraging the planting, care and health of trees throughout the community.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the council of the City of Mason hereby designates and proclaims April 29, 2005 as Arbor Day.


Section 2. That Arbor Day shall be recognized by public activities, promotion, and preservation of this event.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
