

RESOLUTION NO. 2005-13

**URGING THE SOUTHWEST WARREN COUNTY TRANSPORTATION TASK FORCE TO LIST STATE ROUTE 63 BY-PASS AS A HIGH PRIORITY LISTING FOR THE OHIO STATE ROUTE 63 BY-PASS IN WARREN COUNTY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, believes that State Route 63 By-Pass, in Warren County, is essential to meet current traffic demands, as well as future traffic demands; and

WHEREAS, it has not been given sufficient high priority in the opinion of the City Council of the City of Mason; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to give strong support for adding State Route 63 By-Pass through Warren County as a high priority by the Southwest Warren County Task Force.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Council of the City of Mason urges the Southwest Warren County Transportation Task Force to reconsider State Route 63-By-Pass as a high priority project.

Section 2. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to provide for the safety our community and all of Warren County.
