

RESOLUTION NO. 2005-20

**COMMENDING JOHN McCURLEY FOR HIS OUTSTANDING
DEDICATION AND SERVICE TO THE CITY OF MASON, OHIO**

WHEREAS, JOHN McCURLEY has given dedicated service to the City of Mason, Ohio, serving as Council Member since December 1989; and

WHEREAS, JOHN McCURLEY has been a member of the Finance, Equipment, Economic Development, Building, Fire Organization, Public Works, Public Utilities, OKI, Safety and Downtown Committees; and

WHEREAS, JOHN McCURLEY was Mayor of the City of Mason from December 1999 to 2003; and

WHEREAS, JOHN McCURLEY has attended approximately 369 Council meetings and certified 2,779 ordinances and 342 resolutions; and

WHEREAS, JOHN McCURLEY served on the Planning Commission from December 1989 to the present and attended approximately 192 Planning Commission meetings; and

WHEREAS, JOHN McCURLEY has experienced growth of the City of Mason from 1989, with an approximate population of less than 12,000 residents to today's population of over 29,000; and

WHEREAS, JOHN McCURLEY by said service, has shown leadership, enthusiasm, and energy and his contributions and dedication have had a profound impact on the well being of this community.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio:

Section 1. That John McCurley is hereby given the commendation of the Council of the City of Mason for his outstanding and distinguished service to said City.
