

ORDINANCE NO. 2006-105

**AUTHORIZING THE ACTING CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO
A CONTRACT WITH SUNESIS CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR
THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE MUDDY CREEK RESTORATION
AND SANITARY SEWER IMPROVEMENTS AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, bids have been received for the construction of the Muddy Creek Restoration and Sanitary Sewer Improvements; and

WHEREAS, Sunesis Construction Company, is the lowest and best bidder with a bid of \$1,424,153.25 for the construction of the Muddy Creek Restoration and Sanitary Sewer Improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, five members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the bid of Sunesis Construction Company, in the amount of \$1,424,153.25, is hereby accepted as the lowest and best bid for the construction of the Muddy Creek Restoration and Sanitary Sewer Improvements.


Section 2. That the Acting City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Sunesis Construction Company, for the construction of the Muddy Creek Restoration and Sanitary Sewer Improvements, according to the specifications set forth by the City.


Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Sunesis Construction Company an amount not to exceed \$1,424,153.25 for said construction services.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to execute the contract prior to the expiration of the bid.
