

ORDINANCE NO. 2006-111

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR GOLF COURSE MANAGEMENT SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Mason believes that it is in the best interest of the City's investment and purchase of the Golf Center at Kings Island to have a management staff in place and ready to operate the Golf Center; and

WHEREAS, the present management staff has formed a company under the name of Recreation Management Services, Inc. (RMS); and

WHEREAS, the City feels that it is in the best interest of the City's investment to retain this group of experienced people; and

WHEREAS, it is the City's desire to maintain the top quality golf course for which the golf course at Kings Island has become known.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, four members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement for golf course management services with Recreation Management Services, Inc. (RMS) according to the terms of the attached contract, which is attached as Exhibit "A" and is incorporated herein by reference, subject to modifications by the Mayor and Vice Mayor of the City of Mason consistent with the overall purpose of this Ordinance.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to have the contract for services in place contemporaneous with operating the golf course.
