

ORDINANCE NO. 2006-114

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO FILE AN APPLICATION AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING FUNDS THROUGH THE CLEAN OHIO CONSERVATION FUND

WHEREAS, the City of Mason is seeking grant funds to acquire approximately 14.431 acres of green space in two grants along the Muddy Creek to protect the floodplain and riparian corridor, and connect two existing City owned properties; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason recognizes the benefits to its citizens of providing greenspace and habitat protection; and

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Public Works Commission, is administering financial assistance for such purposes through the Clean Ohio Conservation Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for two grants and, if awarded, enter into an agreement with the Ohio Public Works Commission to administer one or both grants to implement said program, and that the City Manager is authorized to sign said agreement.

Section 2. That the City of Mason hereby requests the Ohio Public Works Commission to consider and fund its applications for this project.

Section 3. That the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Ordinance to the Ohio Public Works Commission.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
