

ORDINANCE NO. 2006-118

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH ATKINS AND STANG, INC., FOR THE MASON SPORTS PARK SITE AND BUILDING, ELECTRIC, SPORTS LIGHTING AND SECURITY SYSTEM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, bids have been received for the electric and security portions of the Mason Sports Park; and

WHEREAS, Atkins and Stang, Inc., is the lowest and best bidder with a base bid including alternate of \$857,000.00 as a Prime Electrical contractor for the electrical and security portion of the Mason Sports Park

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, five members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the bid of Atkins and Stang, Inc., in the amount of \$857,000.00, is hereby accepted as the lowest and best bid for the electrical and security portion of the Mason Sports Park

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Atkins and Stang, Inc., for the electrical and security portion of the Mason Sports Park, according to the specifications set forth by the City.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Atkins and Stang, Inc., an amount not to exceed \$857,000.00 for said construction services.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to execute the contract prior to the expiration of the bid.
