

ORDINANCE NO. 2006-119

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH J.M.W. PLUMBING COMPANY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE MASON SPORTS PARK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, bids have been received for the construction of the Mason Sports Park; and
WHEREAS, J.M.W.Plumbing Company is the lowest and best bidder with a bid of \$32,000.00 as the plumbing contractor for the construction plumbing portion of the Mason Sports Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, five members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the bid of J.M.W. Plumbing Company, in the amount of \$32,000.00, is hereby accepted as the lowest and best bid for the plumbing portion of the Mason Sports Park


Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with J.M.W. Plumbing Company for the construction of plumbing at the Mason Sports Park according to the specifications set forth by the City.


Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay J.M.W. Plumbing Company an amount not to exceed \$32,000.00 for said construction services.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to execute the contract prior to the expiration of the bid.
