

ORDINANCE NO. 2006-128

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT  
WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE PURPOSE  
OF ACQUIRING FUNDS THROUGH THE TRANSPORTATION  
IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has thirty-nine (39) signalized intersections and various pedestrian signal heads, school warning flashers, and railway warning flashers located throughout the city; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason recognizes the benefits to its residents by replacing the existing incandescent signal bulbs with brighter, longer lasting, and more energy efficient LED signal bulbs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has been awarded a grant through OKI for said project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation, and that the City Manager is authorized to sign said agreement.

Section 2. That the City of Mason hereby supports the LED Signal Light Bulb Replacement Grant for funding through the State of Ohio Transportation Improvement Program.


Section 3. That the Clerk be and she is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Ordinance to the Ohio Department of Transportation.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
