

ORDINANCE NO. 2006-158

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH TECHNICAL MACHINERY FOR A LED VIDEO SCREEN, WITH PRODUCTION CREW, FOR THE RED, RHYTHM & BOOM CONCERT ON JULY 3, 2007

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Technical Machinery for a LED video screen, with production crew, for the Red, Rhythm & Boom Concert on July 3, 2007, as set forth in the contract attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and which is incorporated herein by reference.


Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Technical Machinery an amount not to exceed \$14,970 for 20' x 24' LED video screen, with production crew.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Independent Contractor Form

This contract is entered into, by and between the City of Mason Parks and Recreation Department and Technical Machinery Inc on this 4th day of December, 2006.



1. The contractor shall provide the following services for the department:
Video Screen
2. The contractor shall provide these Services on the following dates at the following times:
Show Date July 3, 2007
3. The contractor shall provide these Services at facilities provided by the department or at another facility contracted by the department.
4. In consideration of services provided by the contractor the department will pay the instructor as follows:
 - \$14,990 flat fee with 10% down payment and balance day of show
5. All contractor fees will be paid in full at the conclusion of each contracted period, as listed above under #2; utilizing the following guidelines:
 - The department shall pay the contractor in full day of show.
 - In the event the contractor must have a lost check replaced the contractor will pay a \$25.00 stop payment fee to the department. The stop payment fee may be taken out of the replacement check, if authorized in writing by the contractor.
 All requests for replacement checks must be made in written form and submitted by the contractor to the department.

Either party has the right to terminate this agreement for any reason upon thirty (30) day written notice.

6. It is understood and acknowledged that the contractor is an independent contractor of the department and is not an employee or agent of the City of Mason. Contractor shall pay and report all taxes applicable to independent contractor, including, without limitation, Federal, State, and Local taxes, social security taxes and unemployment insurance. Instructor shall not be entitled to participate in any benefits offered by the City of Mason to its employees, including but not limited to any health or disability benefits, retirement benefits or other benefits to which the employees of the City of Mason should be entitled.
7. Contractor agrees to abide by present rules and regulations and future rules and regulations of the City of Mason Parks and Recreation Department and the City of Mason.
