

ORDINANCE NO. 2006-160

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH HORTON EMERGENCY VEHICLES FOR THE PURCHASE OF A 2007 TYPE III 169 INCH MODULAR BODY LIFE SQUAD VEHICLE FOR USE BY THE CITY OF MASON FIRE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has advertised and received bids for the purchase of life squad vehicles; and

WHEREAS, Horton Emergency Vehicles was the best bidder with a bid of \$165,000 for the purchase of a 2007 Type III, 169 inch Modular Body life squad vehicle.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the State's life squad vehicle specifications and agrees that Horton Emergency Vehicles is the best bidder.


Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Horton Emergency Vehicles for the purchase of a 2007 Type III, 169 inch Modular Body Life Squad Vehicle.


Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Horton Emergency Vehicles the sum of up to \$165,000 for said life squad vehicle.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
