

ORDINANCE NO. 2006-161

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CONESTOGA-ROVERS & ASSOCIATES TO PROVIDE INCIDENT COMMAND SYSTEM TRAINING INCLUDING THE NIMS PROCESS

WHEREAS, National Incident Management System (“NIMS”) will provide a consistent nationwide approach allowing federal, state, local and tribal governments to work effectively and efficiently to prevent, prepare, or respond to, and recover from domestic incidents; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Homeland Security has mandated that all government agencies at all levels incorporate the National Incident Management System process; and

WHEREAS, Conestoga-Rovers & Associates is a nationally known company that provides Incident Command System training, including the nationally mandated NIMS process; and

WHEREAS, Conestoga-Rovers & Associates has submitted a proposal to provide Incident Command System training.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:


Section 1. That the City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Conestoga-Rovers & Associates pursuant to the terms of the proposal and attached hereto as Exhibit A.


Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Conestoga-Rovers & Associates up to the sum of \$300,000 for said training.
