

ORDINANCE NO. 2006-47

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MEDTRONIC EMERGENCY RESPONSE SYSTEMS FOR LIFEPAK MONITORS TO REPLACE EXISTING CARDIAC MONITOR EQUIPMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has advertised and received bids for the purchase of cardiac monitors/defibrillators; and

WHEREAS, Medtronic Emergency Response Systems is the best bidder with a bid of \$134,721.71 for the purchase of 10 LifePak-12 cardiac monitor/defibrillator units, which includes trade-in credit for the Fire Department's obsolete cardiac monitors/defibrillators.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the State's cardiac monitor/defibrillator specifications and agrees that Medtronic Emergency Response Systems is the best bidder.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Medtronic Emergency Response Systems for the purchase of 10 LifePak-12 cardiac monitor/defibrillator units for use by the Fire Department.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Medtronic Emergency Response Systems an amount not to exceed \$134,721.71, which includes trade-in credit, for said units.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to execute the contract at the soonest possible date in order to acquire the necessary equipment before the limited time discount expires.
