

ORDINANCE NO. 2006-73

**CHANGING THE NAME OF PIN OAK COURT IN THE LANDING OF
OAKWOOD LAKES TO RED OAK COURT AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 723.04 permits the legislative authority of a municipal corporation, on petition by a person owning a lot in the municipal corporation, to change the name of a street upon certain findings; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has received a petition from Grand Communities Ltd.; and

WHEREAS, Grand Communities Ltd. Owns a lot in the City of Mason in The Landing of Oakwood Lakes; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that another street in Deerfield Township is already named Pin Oak Court; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to R.C. 723.04, the Council for the City of Mason is satisfied that good cause exists to change the name of Pin Oak Court to Red Oak Court and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Council for the City of Mason hereby finds that there is good cause and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest to change the name of Pin Oak Court pursuant to the petition submitted by Grand Communities Ltd.


Section 2. That the name of Pin Oak Court in The Landing of Oakwood Lakes is hereby changed to Red Oak Court.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to change the name of the street as soon as possible in order to insure proper provision of public services for residents of the street in question.
