

ORDINANCE NO. 2006-85

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MULTITRODE FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF SCADA SOFTWARE FOR LIFT STATIONS

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has previously purchased equipment and computer software from MultiTrode for a Supervisory Control And Data Acquisition (SCADA) system for the City's remote sanitary sewage lift stations; and

WHEREAS, additional equipment and computer software, proprietary to MultiTrode, is now necessary for alarm purposes, and

WHEREAS, MultiTrode has proposed to furnish and install the necessary equipment and computer software to provide the alarms, to provide training on the new equipment and computer software, and to re-locate the entire SCADA system to the City's new Water Reclamation Plant (WRP), for a total cost of \$24,485.00,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the proposal of \$24,485.00 from MultiTrode for additional SCADA equipment and computer software, training on the new equipment, and re-location of the entire SCADA system to the City's new WRP.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with MultiTrode.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay MultiTrode the sum of \$24,485.00 upon successful completion of the agreed-upon services.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
