

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-1

ARBOR DAY

WHEREAS, Arbor Day has been an occasion for recognizing the value of trees and woodlands to human welfare since 1872; and

WHEREAS, trees clean the air, moderate the temperature, reduce erosion of topsoil, cut heating and cooling costs, and provide habitat for wildlife; and

WHEREAS, trees are a renewable resource and beautify our residential and business areas; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has a tradition of supporting and encouraging the planting, care and health of trees throughout the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the council of the City of Mason hereby designates and proclaims April 22, 2006 as Arbor Day.

Section 2. That Arbor Day shall be recognized by public activities, promotion, and preservation of this event on April 22, 2006.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
