

RESOLUTION 2006-06

COMMENDING ERNIE STICKLER
ON HIS DISTINGUISHED SERVICE TO THE
CITY OF MASON, OHIO

Whereas, Ernie Stickler was instrumental in establishing the plans and building of Mason's new Water Reclamation Plant; and

Whereas, Ernie Stickler has enhanced community spirit by presenting tours and lectures to school, scout, church and other groups; and

Whereas, Ernie Stickler has been President of the Ohio Water Environment Association Southwest Section in 2001, he is a Operator Training Committee of Ohio Trustee, he is a seated member of the Joint Committee on Plastics with NSF International, he is a member of the Quarter Century Operators Club for the Ohio Water Environment Association, and he is a member of the Select Society of Sanitary Sludge Shovelers); and

Whereas, Ernie Stickler earned his second Class IV license in 2004, and at that time he was one of 13 active operators in Ohio with a Class IV Water and Waste Water License; and

Whereas, by said service to the City of Mason, Ernie Stickler has promoted the well being of this community, has inspired City employees and has prepared the Public Utilities Department for the challenges of the 21st century.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio:

Section 1. That Ernie Stickler is hereby given the commendation of the Council of the City of Mason for his outstanding and distinguished service to said City.
