Eric then reported on the following future projects:


- Western Row Road widening

- Traffic Signal at Tylersville Road and Fireside Drive
- Muddy Creek bike path


Implement new sidewalk program  
Pursue a full interchange at Western Row Road and I-71  
Eric noted the recent events including the unveiling of the Mayor's Wall and he distributed a City  
calendar made possible at no cost to the City by a partnership with the Pulse Journal.

Councilmember Tony Bradburn reported the Safety Committee has been working on and will  
soon be installing monitors at the intersections so traffic signals can respond quickly to traffic  
conditions. He explained the research that has gone into this project and noted other communities  
that have used it successfully.

Chamber members mentioned the Bethany Road and SR 741 intersection as being a signal that  
needs to be reviewed. He also noted there is no left turn signal at Tylersville Road and Fairway  
Drive. He said when heading eastbound, there is a sight clearance reduction due to the rise in the  
roadway.
