

ORDINANCE NO. 2007 - 103

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FMSM ENGINEERS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$49,400, FOR DESIGN OF US 42 NORTH TRUNK SEWER RECONSTRUCTION (PHASE 2B) AND PREPARATION OF BIDDING DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has pursued a program to reconstruct the US 42 Trunk Sewer, which has become deteriorated and a source of extraneous water (infiltration/inflow) to the City's sanitary sewer system; and

WHEREAS, FMSM Engineers has proposed to furnish engineering services to design the reconstruction of the US 42 North Trunk Sewer, from 3rd Avenue to S. East Street and from Kings Mills Road to US 42 North, and to prepare plans and specifications to solicit bids for the construction, for a total cost not to exceed \$49,400.00; and

WHEREAS, FMSM Engineers has demonstrated the expertise to perform the proposed work on previous projects for the City of Mason.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the proposal of \$49,400.00 from FMSM Engineers for design of sanitary sewers and preparation of plans and specifications.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with FMSM Engineers for the proposed work.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay FMSM Engineers the sum of \$49,400.00 upon successful completion of the agreed-upon services.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
