

ORDINANCE NO. 2007 -104

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH R.D. ZANDE & ASSOCIATES INC., IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$36,000, FOR DESIGN AND PREPARATION OF BIDDING DOCUMENTS FOR PARTIAL DEMOLITION OF THE OLD WATER RECLAMATION PLANT

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has constructed a new Water Reclamation Plant (WRP) located at 3200 Mason-Morrow-Millgrove Road, and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has taken the old WRP located at 3920 US 42 North out of service, and

WHEREAS, it is the City's desire to demolish portions of the old WRP in order to provide for future beneficial use of the site; and

WHEREAS, R.D. Zande & Associates Inc. has proposed to furnish engineering services for the design and preparation of bidding documents for partial demolition of the old WRP, for a total cost not to exceed \$36,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the City has reviewed this proposal and determined it to be reasonable and responsive to the City's requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the proposal of \$36,000.00 from R.D. Zande & Associates Inc. for design and preparation of bidding documents for partial demolition of the old WRP.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with R.D. Zande & Associates for the proposed work.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay R.D. Zande & Associates Inc. the sum of \$36,000.00 upon successful completion of the agreed-upon services.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
